WAGES AND BENEFITS FOR RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN

Section 3.06. (a) The minimum hourly rate of wages shall be as follows:

1 YEAR AGREEMENT June 1st, 2011 through May 31st, 2012

RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN	\$25.56	75%	OF JOURNEYMAN WIREMAN RATE
FOREMAN		20%	OF RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN RATE
SUB FOREMAN		10%	OF RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN RATE

APPRENTICE RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN:

PERIOD	WAGES
1 ST	50% OF RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN RATE
2 ND	55% OF RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN RATE
3 RD *	60% OF RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN RATE
4 TH	65% OF RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN RATE
5 TH	70% OF RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN RATE
6 TH	75% OF RESIDENTIAL WIREMAN RATE
Completion	100%

*Pension begins

Upon completion of apprenticeship and passing the RI JW Licensing Exam all licensed journeyman will remain as a Residential Journeymen for a five [5] year period.
